### **VP Elections**

Three nominations were confirmed to run for the VP of DSOA. Next step is to have a Nomination Meeting. The Executive Committee has discussed the voting and election procedures to ensure the By-Laws and Operations & Procedures are followed.

### **Masks Violations**

The EC discussed the new rule that DIAA now allows double gators for players (only for players).

### **General Discussion of the Season**

The EC discussed the new protocols for 2 minute breaks and playing quarters, and how it is being executed so far.

The committee also discussed games starting late and that they cannot be played in the dark. Some games are getting shorter periods due to that.

### **Payments**

The Executive Committee has confirmed sending checks from TD bank directly to pay the referees, instead of using the Arbiter. This will eliminate transfer fees and save the Association's money.

Completed - DSOA paid \$680.80 for NFHS registration. This ensures that our officials working in the Fall are insured.

In Progress - DIAA fees are to be paid by check by DSOA directly to DIAA.

### **New Officials**

Four officials are interested in joining DSOA. The committee had discussed waiting on bringing them on after the fall season due to the shortened season, no training available, and other related issues.

### **Judicial Committee Recommendations**

The EC discussed the recommendations and the next steps. The committee agreed on presenting the recommendations to the general membership for voting. It requires scheduling another general meeting to discuss and vote on them.

Action - General Meeting to allow membership to vote on the Judicial Committee recommendations is scheduled for December 3, 2020.
